Be Aware

COVID-19 continues to be a presence and risk on Madeline Island and in mainland communities in nearby Ashland and Bayfield Counties.

COVID is infecting people who are vaccinated and not vaccinated. It has been confirmed among all age groups, including children, young adults, and seniors.

Be Responsible

Please help limit the risk of COVID exposure in our community. The remoteness of the island creates additional health-care and treatment challenges for visitors and residents alike. We encourage you to follow these basic precautions.

- **Keep your distance.** Stay at least 6 feet away from people who are not part of your regular circle.
- **Wear a mask.** Definitely indoors. Definitely anytime you are in close proximity to others, indoors or out.
- **Wash your hands.** Soap, sanitizer – your choice.
- **Isolate yourself.** If you get sick, have symptoms, or are exposed to someone who has COVID, stay home for 10 days or until a test confirms that you are not infected. Please don't spread the virus to others.

Be Patient

Many of our businesses and organizations have scaled back for the season, or reduced access for public health reasons. Many are short-staffed and doing their best to provide service. Please relax, be understanding, and be courteous, especially since there now are fewer options on the island.
